You need to be claiming certain benefits to qualify.

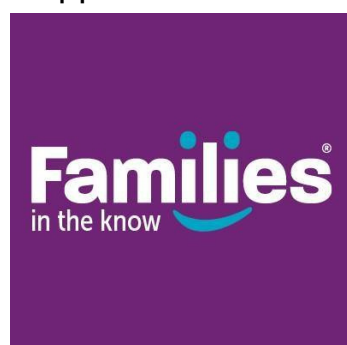
If you're pregnant and under 18 you can claim even if you do not receive any benefits.

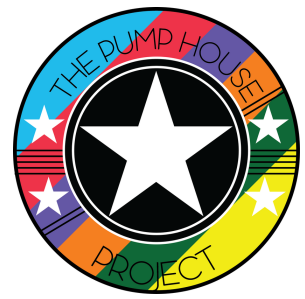

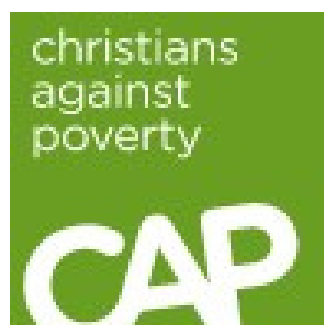
