How many people visit each year? Would you like to visit? If you did, what would you most like to see – Opera? Ballet?</p> <p>Or -</p> <p>Research theatre jobs – what does a director do? Set designer? Play wright? Costume designer? Find out more about one of these roles. Would you be interested to work in a theatre one day?
